I. ABOUT DAYTONA BEACH

With so much to do for all ages, Daytona Beach is the perfect vacation spot. The city is known for its beach with over 23 miles (37 km) of white sandy beaches open to pedestrians without time restrictions. Cars can be driven on some of the beaches during daylight hours due to the hard-packed sand. There are more than ten waterfront parks in Daytona Beach.

This hard-packed sand made Daytona Beach a mecca for motorsports, and the old Daytona Beach Road Course hosted races for over 50 years. This was replaced in 1959 by Daytona International Speedway. The city is also the headquarters for NASCAR.

The Museum of Arts and Sciences is the primary cultural facility for Daytona Beach and Volusia County. Other museums located in the city include the Southeast Museum of Photography and the Halifax Historical Museum. The Museum of Arts and Sciences is actually a collection of museums and galleries and includes the Klancke Environmental Complex, the Cuban Museum, Root Family Museum featuring one of the largest Coca-Cola collections in the world, the Dow American Gallery and the Bouchelle Center for Decorative Arts which together form what is probably one of the finest collections of furniture and decorative arts in the Southeast. It also includes the Cici and Hyatt Brown Museum of Art, which houses the largest collection of Florida art in the world.

During the month of October, the average high temperature in Daytona is 89.9 degrees Fahrenheit (28.8 degrees Celsius), with an average low of 69.0 degrees Fahrenheit (20.6 degrees Celsius).

II. COMPETITION VENUE

Ocean Center Convention Center

Address: 101 N. Atlantic Ave., Daytona Beach, FL 32118

The Ocean Center is a modern, state-of-the-art, multipurpose facility located in the heart of Daytona Beach, FL. The venue is just a short walk from the accommodations arranged for the 2023 Veteran World Championships, only 400 feet from the world-renowned Daytona Beach, and provides easy access to a variety of shops and entertainment.

Named the 2019 Stella Gold Award Winner for Best Convention Center in the Southeast, the Ocean Center opened in 1985 and was expanded in 2009, doubling the facility's size. It features more than 200,000 square feet of flexible indoor and outdoor meeting space

The Ocean Center incorporates sun, sand, surf and speed into its fourteen Art in Public Places works. In February 2015, the center installed the NASCAR Stock Car Hall of Fame exhibit to pay tribute to the area's rich racing history. The exhibit honors legendary drivers and personalities in stock car racing, and includes photos and plaques of 58 inductees.

III. PARTICIPATION

All participating athletes are required to have an FIE License, per the FIE Statutes and Administrative rules.

REGISTRATION

The registration of athletes and officials from the delegations must be done through the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE Rules and the quotas of delegations. Photos of athletes and officials from the delegations registered on the FIE website must be uploaded on the FIE website.

Also, entries must be sent to the organizers by the competitors' national federation. Entries must be sent no later than one month before the beginning of the championship.

ENTRY FEES

Payment of registration fees can be completed by wire transfer. Individual Registration Fees are 90.00 Euros per fencer, per event, and Team Registration Fees are 185.00 Euros per team, per event. Transfer information is below for our bank:

V. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will start on the 10th of October and finish at the end of the World Championships. It will be held in the competition venue and according to the below schedule:

Participants cannot be allowed to use equipment control, the training venue, competition halls, or any other facility without accreditation. The head of the delegation can collect the accreditation showing proof of bank transfer or paying the entry fees required, only by cash.

VI. TRAVEL/VISA REQUESTS

If you do need a visa, please urgently apply. It can take several weeks to or more to obtain a visa if you are traveling from non-VWP countries.

Once you have applied please note your DS-160 number, you will then need to pay the visa fee to the US Government, following the instructions.

After applying, you should select the earliest available appointment date (even if beyond the date of travel), then if needed can re-enter the scheduling system and select the "Request Expedite" option. If this still does not result in a satisfactory appointment date, please reach out to us at the contact details below.

VI. TRAVEL/VISA REQUESTS - CONT'D

Though it is not required to have a visa invitation letter for the interview process, we are happy to provide one, in order to provide this or any other assistance, we need you to fill out the form available here: 2023 FIE Veteran World Championship Visa Invitation Letter. It is important to receive your ESTA or Visa as appropriate as soon as possible. Delegations are encouraged to make this their highest priority.

The ESTA or VWP may be used by the following nations except where an individual has visited the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (North Korea, DPRK), Islamic Republic of Iran, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria or Yemen. You may not use the VWP if you are also a dual national of PRK, IRI, Iraq, Sudan or Syria. You may not use the VWP if you have a criminal record.

Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Chile, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Lichenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Republic of Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Chinese Taipei and the United Kingdom.

VII. NATIONAL ANTHEM AND FLAG

All the National Anthems that will be used during the FIE Veteran World Championships shall not exceed 75 seconds in length and they need to be sent to the LOC, in addition to an image of the flag, at email before the 27th of September. When the head of delegation collects the accreditations, we will kindly ask you to sign a form to confirm that the anthem and flag emailed to us match the ones you want to be used during the World Championships.

VIII. EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

- All the equipment must comply with FIE regulations and will be checked under control of the FIE SEMI commission and all the fencers of the same team have to be the same.
- It is mandatory to put the logos of the countries on both legs of the breeches. The surname of the athlete and the name of the country must be printed on the back of the jacket and/or electric jacket.
- All the advertising and manufacturer logos must be in conformity with the FIE Publicity Code requirements and will be checked.

IX. AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Airport transfers will be arranged for participants from the following airports to the official hotels for the competition ONLY. Price for transfers is to be determined and will be provided at a later date:

- Daytona Beach (DAB), 5 miles/8 km
- Orlando (MCO), 75 miles/120 km

Delegations MUST submit flight information to the organizer in order to be able to utilize the shuttles that will take members from these airports to their hotel. TIME ZONE
